

Call for a Head of Unit Sustainable Development

The International Union of Railways (UIC) is looking for a Head of Unit - Sustainable Development in Paris. The UIC is a world-wide organisation for international cooperation among railways and promotion of rail transport.

Sustainable Development and Environmental activities are of strategic importance to UIC members, and are of growing importance for railways all over the world. The aim of the Sustainable Development Unit of UIC is in particular to

- More than 7 years of relevant professional experience, preferably in the railway sector

- High ability and experience in coordinating teams and managing projects, preferably in an intercultural work environment,
- A very good overview of sustainable development issues, with an emphasis on transport and railways
- Excellent communication skills, tact and diplomacy, intercultural competence, network and social skills,
- Excellent skills in English (spoken and written) and good skills in at least one other language
- Dynamic attitude and strong commitment to Environment and Sustainability,
- Very good analytical and presentational skills.
