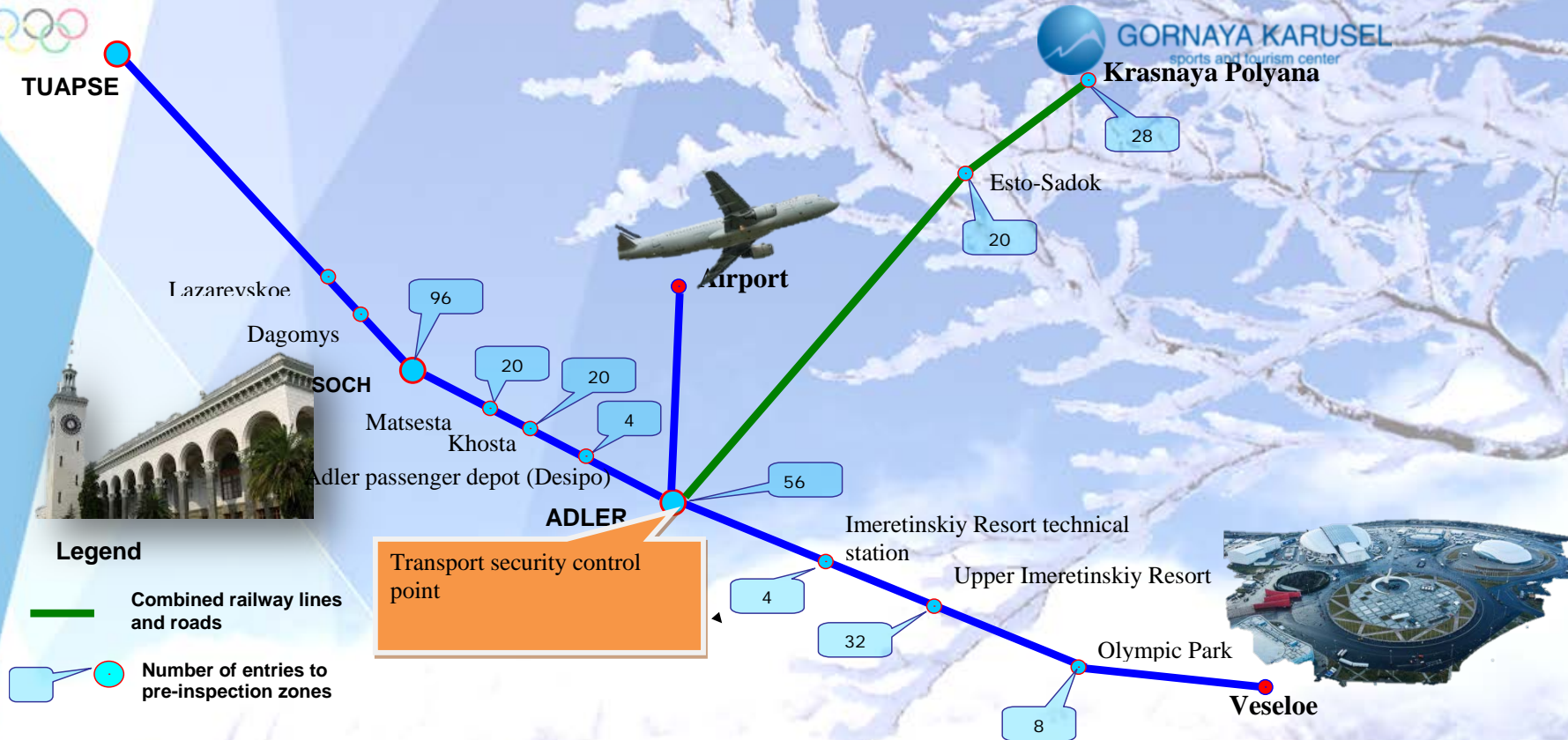

THE RAILWAY INFRASTRUCTURE PROTECTION SYSTEM PROVIDES FOR:

- **constant, real time monitoring of the situation in any weather conditions are facilities and in control zones;**
- **timely discovery of outsiders in the control zones of facilities and halt to attempts at unlawful intervention in railway transport operations;**
- **management by security divisions for halting unlawful intervention in railway transport activities;**
- **reliable protection of the key facilities;**
- **prompt notification of law-enforcement agencies and security forces for them to take steps against offenders;**
- **timely transfer of the requisite information to the traffic dispatch service for deciding on changes to the train timetable in order to preclude accidents (crashes).**

PROTECTION OF THE RZD INFRASTRUCTURE BY TECHNICAL MEANS



**Set up at facilities:
3531 video surveillance cameras,
569 thermal cameras,
55 sets of radar stations.**



PROTECTION OF STATION COMPLEXES BY TECHNICAL MEANS



288 inspection points were set up at **11** Sochi hub railway stations



Over **5.8 m** people passed through the inspection points.
3 m units of baggage were checked.
12 prohibited items were discovered.



Guarding of RZD facilities

The facilities were guarded by forces of:
the departmental guard of the Ministry of transport of
the Russian Federation,
Private security organisations.



During the Olympic Games, **234** RZD facilities were under guard, including:

16 stations,

42 railway and **32** road bridges,

23 tunnels, etc.



General information

The participants in the Olympic Games included delegations from **88** countries, **6000** sportsmen and team members.

The participants in the Olympic Games included delegations from **45** countries, **1 600** Paralympic sportsmen and team members.

3000 staff members and over **25 000** volunteers.

During the Olympic Games, on a daily basis, according to the timetable, **38** local fast trains made **413** journeys, carrying about **200 thousand** visitors to and participants in the Games (the maximum number of passengers was over **311 thousand** in one day).

In total, during the Olympic and Paralympic Games, the railways carried about **4.4 m** passengers.
