
Main activities

- **Training and Educational** Programs (Middle-East Rail Training Center MERTCe established 2012 in Turkey)






UIC's core mission – Railway Harmonisation








UIC Standardisation - Overview

In UIC the Standardisation is managed by the **Standardisation Platform** created by the General Assembly from which it depends.

The Standardisation Platform implements the guidelines and the strategies decided by the UIC General Assembly.

Mission

- 1. Coordination of the International Railway Standards (IRS) developed by and asked to the UIC Forums
- 2. Identification and coordination of the **Clusters business cases** oriented
- 3. Coordination of the updating of the **UIC Leaflets**
- 4. Identification and coordination of the standardisation of the Railway Operating Rules
- 5. Definition and negotiation of the Cooperation Agreement with the other **Standardisation Organisations**



UIC Standardisation - Outputs

The cornerstones that support UIC standardisation are:

1. International Railway Standards (IRS)

2. Clusters

They are coordinated sets of standards and documents aimed to standardise the precompetitive items of the railway services.


3. UIC Leaflets and their updating

They are the basic asset of UIC and they are the source of railway knowledge for operations, for technical aspects and for other standards.



A priority for UIC: creating conditions for Seamless Rail Freight Transport




