Next Station 2011, the 3rd international conference on railway stations to be held on 17 and 18 March 2011 in Brussels

(Brussels/Paris, 3 September 2010) Following the successful editions in Rome (2005) and Paris (2007), the 3rd 'Next Station' international conference will take place in Brussels, on 17 and 18 March 2011. This high-profile global railway event will be hosted by SNCB Holding in close collaboration with the International Union of Railways (UIC).
