## Stefano Antonio Donnarumma (FS Group) appointed new Vice Chair of the global railway organisation UIC

The Regional Assembly for Europe of the International Union of Railways (UIC) has also confirmed the Chief Executive Officer and General Manager of the FS Group as Head of the European region for the 2026-2027 two-year term

(Paris, Brussels, Warsaw, 12 December 2025) The Chief Executive Officer and General Manager of the FS Group, Stefano Antonio Donnarumma, has been appointed as the new Vice Chair of the UIC (Union Internationale des Chemins de fer), the global organisation that brings together railways and major railway stakeholders from around the world.

Donnarumma has also been confirmed as Head of the UIC Europe Region for the period 2026-2027 by the UIC Regional Assembly for Europe.

"I am honoured to have been appointed Vice Chair of the UIC and to see my role as leader of the Europe Region confirmed for the 2026-2027 term," Donnarumma said. "The coming years will be crucial for developing high-speed connections between major European cities, thanks also to the High-Speed Masterplan, which offers an extraordinary opportunity for integration and growth. Along this path, cooperation with fellow CEOs of the railway companies represented by the UIC will be essential, as we share the vision of an increasingly connected network. I take on these responsibilities with enthusiasm and determination, committing myself to promoting fast, safe and sustainable rail links capable of strengthening mobility across our continent and supporting the ecological transition."

In his dual role, the CEO and General Manager of the FS Group will work closely with the other members to promote, at both regional and global levels, a competitive, sustainable and attractive rail transport system.
