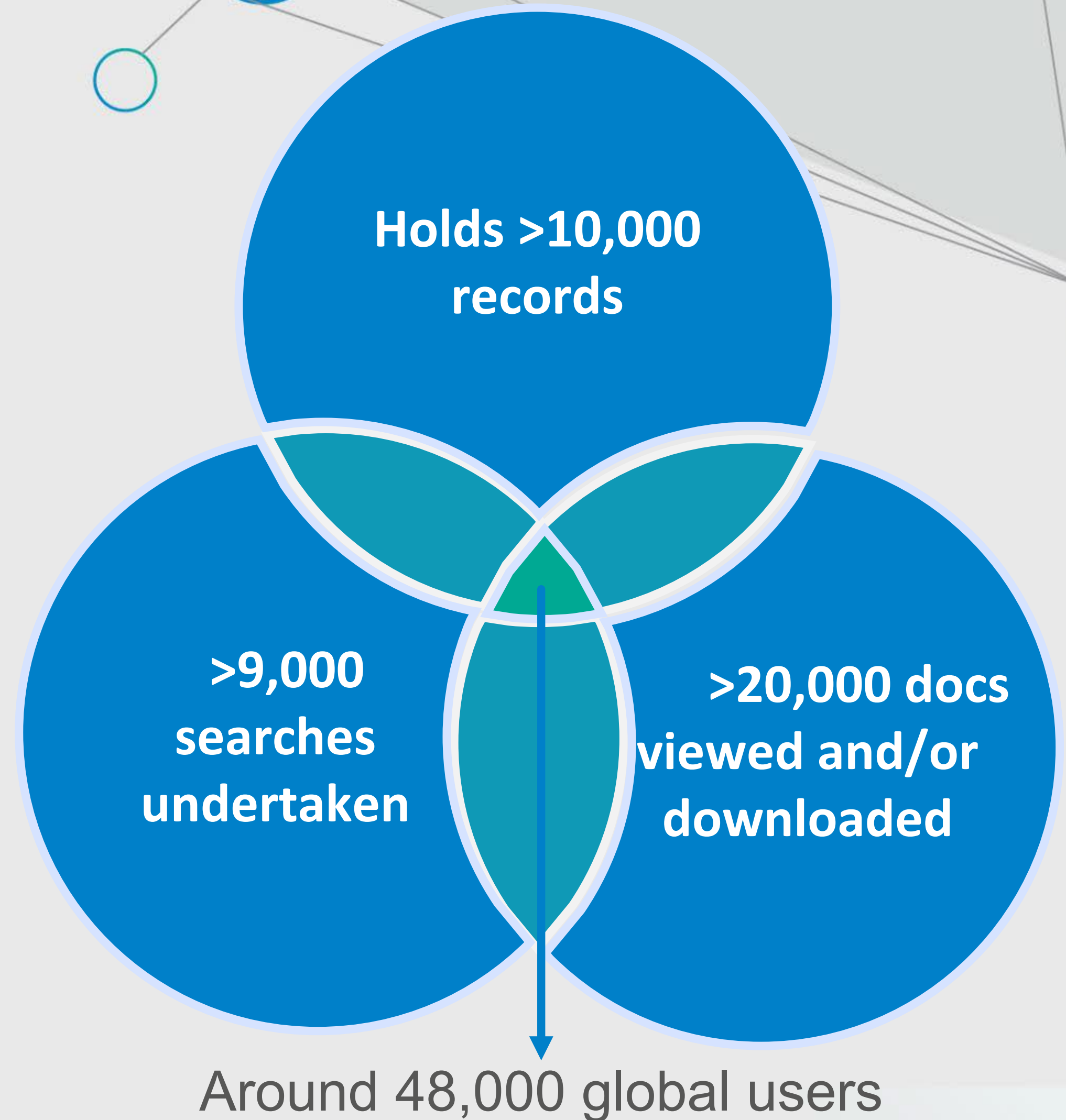

- Content has grown from an initial small load of 900 records to **>10,000 in 2022**
- Curated and managed database by experienced transport librarians
- **Physical library** located at Port Melbourne, holding hard copy and digital material on land transport.
- Supported by Australian State and Federal Governments

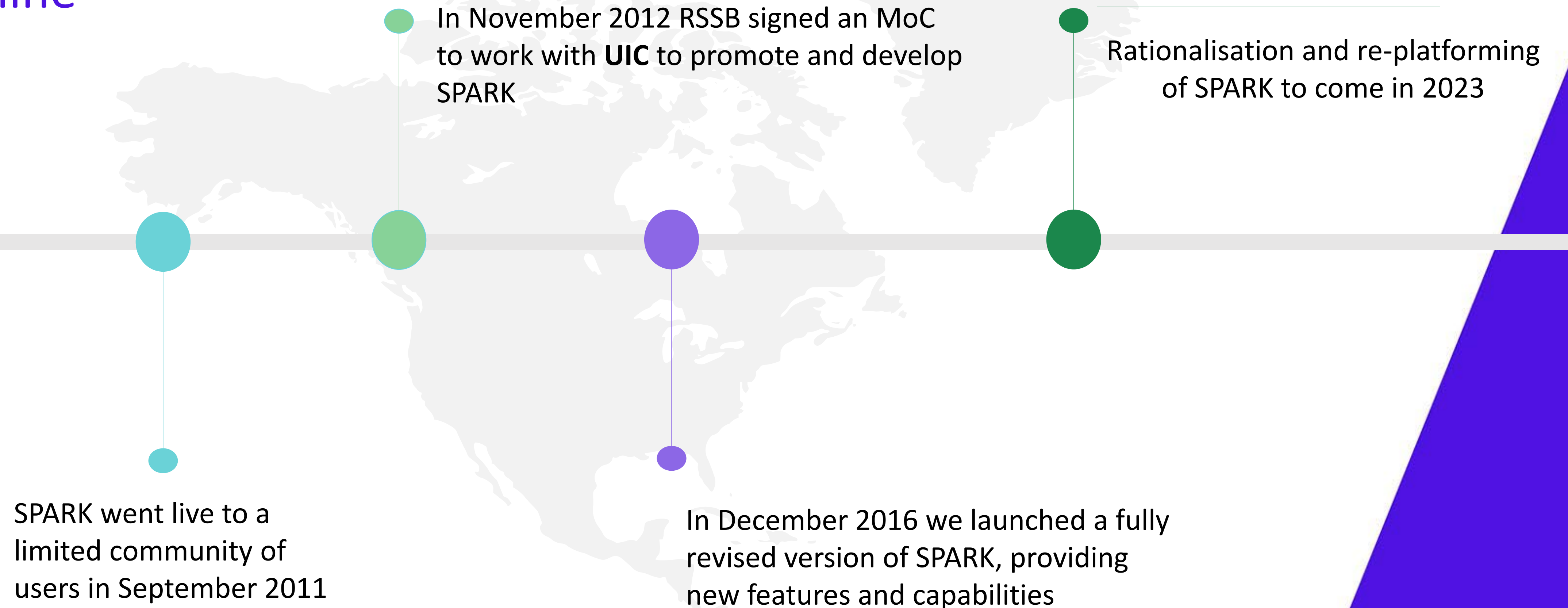
