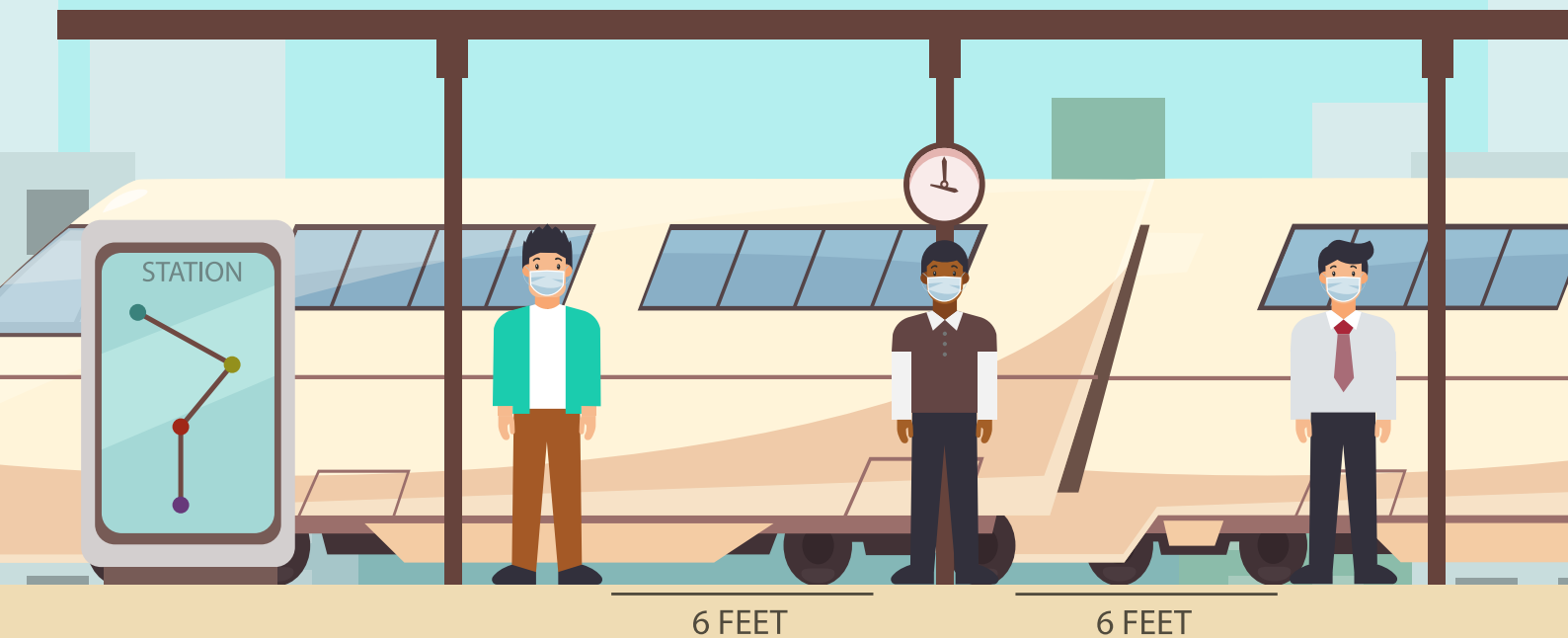

# MAIN VISITS

## Centralized Train Traffic Control Center



KORAIL operates and monitors more than 89%, out of about 4,200 km the total service length, by Centralized Traffic Control Center. The nationwide trains, which are KTX, conventional and freight train and subway in metropolitan area, are under control of the center. This center is essential for the safe rail service with various advanced technology of signal and IT, and knowhow from all sectors in railway. It also is control and manage incidents for quick and safe restorage in railway lines.

## KORAIL's High-Speed train riding experience



KORAIL started its first high speed train from 2004, which is called KTX (Korean Train eXpress). It continued to develop the high-speed train and implemented the service of KTX Sancheon manufactured with pure Korea's technology in 2010. It runs at 300 km/h and has provided people with a travel to any place of Korea in half a day.

## KORAIL Training Center *(fostering train controllers)*



KORAIL was designated as the sole training provider for train controllers in Korea from the government. Participants can take a look at the curriculum and facilities to foster train controllers. KORAIL operates passenger and freight railways, which means that the education is for the both of railway service.

## Seoul tour



All participants are going to visit Gyeong-bok-gung palace built in 1395 during the period of Chosun Dynasty. It is featured as a background of many K-dramas and movies. And they will have a chance to watch a musical show telling Korea's beautiful story. These experiences make them understand about Korea's culture.

Due to these principles, the attendance to ALL the sessions is therefore mandatory.

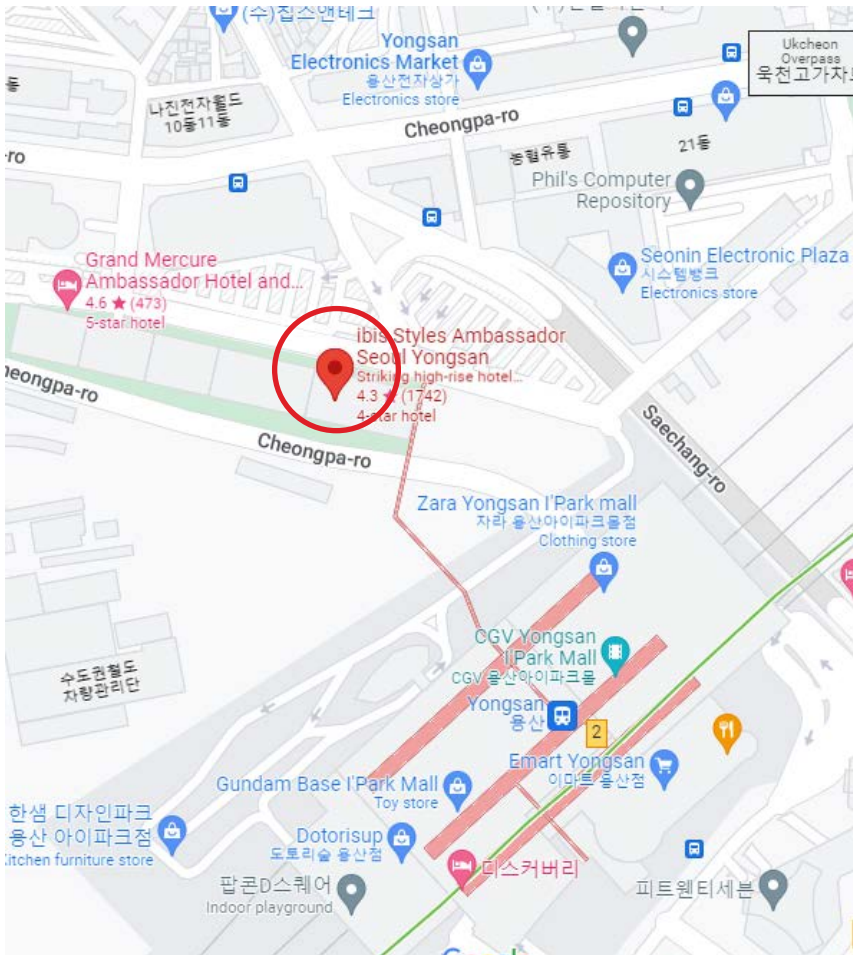

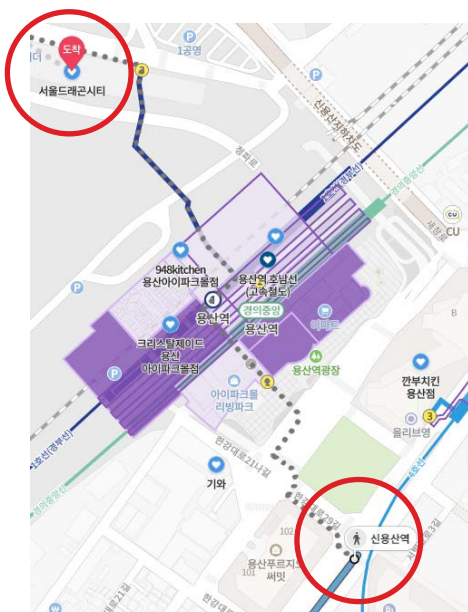

## How to get to hotel from Incheon Int'l airport (airport limousine bus)

- ▶ Number of bus: 6001 (Boarding: 1<sup>st</sup> floor and No. 5 of terminal 1 / B1 No.29 of terminal 2)
- ▶ Journey time: about 1 hour 20 minutes
- ▶ Stop: Sin Yongsan Station (15 minutes by walk to the hotel)
- ▶ Fare: 16,000 KWR (about USD 12) \* It is to paid by each participant.
